DESIGNATION OF NEWSPAPERS TO RECEIVE MEETING AGENDAS AND NOTICES OF APPLICATIONS FOR 2026


WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, specifically, N.J.S.A. 10:4-8.d, provides that all public bodies shall designate at least two newspapers to receive written advance notice of at least 48 hours, giving the time, date, location and, to the extent known, the agenda of any regular, special or rescheduled meeting, which notice shall accurately state whether formal action may or may not be taken and which notice, besides being prominently posted in at least one public place reserved for such or similar announcements, shall also be mailed, telephoned, telegraphed or hand delivered to at least two newspapers which newspapers shall be designated by the public body as having the greatest likelihood of informing the public within the municipality, one of which shall be the official newspaper if the public body or the governing body of the municipality so designates;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Land Use Law, specifically, N.J.S.A. 40:55D-12.a, provides that notices of hearings on applications shall be published in the official newspaper of the municipality, if there be one, or in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Raritan Township Planning Board on January 14, 2026, as follows:

1. The Board hereby designates the Courier News as an official newspaper for notice purposes as the Board is of the opinion that the Hunterdon County Democrat has a great likelihood of informing the public within the municipality of Board meetings and applications.

2. The Board hereby also designates the Times of Trenton as an official newspaper for notice purposes as the Board is of the opinion that the Courier News has a great likelihood of informing the public within the municipality of Board meetings and applications.
