Speed Limit Change along County Route 523 in Raritan Township

**WHEREAS**, The County of Hunterdon desires to amend a Resolution adopted August 2, 2022 with the respect to speed limits along Flemington-Stockton Road (County Route 523) in the Borough of Stockton and the Townships of Delaware and Raritan:

SECTION 1: That the speed limit(s) for both directions of traffic along Stockton-Flemington Road (County Route 523) from New Jersey Route 29 to New Jersey Route 12 in the Borough of Stockton and the Townships of Delaware and Raritan shall be as follows:

- ZONE 1: 30 MPH in STOCKTON BOROUGH from N.J. Route 29 to the Northerly Stockton Borough line, thence
- ZONE 2: 45 MPH in DELAWARE TOWNSHIP to 1900' south of the center of Rosemont - Ringoes Road (County Route 604), thence
- ZONE 3: 35 MPH in DELAWARE TOWNSHIP to 350' south of the center of Rosemont - Ringoes Road (County Route 604), thence
- ZONE 4: 25 MPH in DELAWARE TOWNSHIP to 475' north of the center of Rosemont - Ringoes Road (County Route 604), thence
- ZONE 5: 35 MPH in DELAWARE TOWNSHIP to 350' north of the center of Delaware Drive, thence
- ZONE 6: 45 MPH in DELAWARE TOWNSHIP AND RARITAN TOWNSHIP to the center of South Autumn Leaf Boulevard, thence
- ZONE 7: 40 MPH in RARITAN TOWNSHIP to the N.J. Route 12 Traffic Circle.

Section 2: Regulatory and Warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits as designated by the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon the date of Adoption by the Board of Commissioners.
